

- Packaging materials are made of 100 % recycled materials and dyed with white clay






PACKAGING

- Bioplastics
- All bottles 125ml, 250ml and 500ml are made of sugarcane from Brazil

- All waste water is reused
- Filter cakes and waste water is used as fertilizers, reduces the use of synthetic fertilizers
- Bagasse is used as an energy source, it is an important part of the energy matrix

INGREDIENTS IN A SKINCARE PRODUCT

- Fatty Acids
- Water
- Emulsifier agents
- Thickening agents
- Surfactants
- Active ingredients
- Preservatives





TO PRODUCE AN EMULSION

- An emulsion is a mixture of two liquids, e.g. water and oil
- An emulsifier is a substance that facilitates the formation of the emulsion
- Dish washing liquid is a common emulsifier
- Example of emulsion milk

SELECTION OF OIL

Vegetable oil

Contains fatty acids and vitamins. Used as nourishment to the skin.

Animal oil

Contains fatty acids and vitamins. Used as nourishment to the skin.

Synthetic oil

Contains no fatty acids or vitamins. Can not be used to nourish the skin.

Mineral oil/Fossil oil

Contains no fatty acids or vitamins. Can not be used to nourish the skin.





VEGETABLE OIL



- Formed in the building life cycle of the plant
- The oil is produced in the seeds and fruits

Examples are:

- Jojoba oil
- Rapeseed oil
- Olive oil

Questionable vegetable oils:

- Listed as Vegetable oil but could be reused vegetable oil from the fast food industry
- PEG-oils that always contain harmful solvents



ANIMAL INGREDIENTS

- Sebum, lard, E471, Adeps Bovis
- Cetyl Palmitate (Spermaceti)
- Stearyl Alcohol
- Stearic Acid

- Collagen The Guardian has discovered a Chinese cosmetics company using skin, harvested from the corpses of executed convicts, to develop beauty products to be sold in Europe.

PERSIAN SILK TREE

- Persian silk tree (Albizia julibrissin) is an alternative to Collagen
- Protects skin cells by producing melatonin
- Works by improving respiration, ridding the skin of toxic glycogens, increases cellular energy and reduces the formation of dark spots





SYNTHETIC OILS

- Produced by artificial means, do not exist naturally
- The chemist's dream anything is possible
- Examples of silicone oils:
 - · Dimethicone
 - Diphenyl Demethicone
 - Dimethiconol
 - · Cyclomethicone
 - · Methicone
- When silicone oils are decomposed, they form Formaldehyde
- Difficult for nature to decompose
- Bioaccumulative (source TOX-INFO del 7)





FACTS ABOUT MINERAL OIL


- Petroleum
- A mixture of hundreds of different hydrocarbons
- A thick, dark liquid
- Occurs in areas with loose ground sheet
- Formed by dead plants and animals
- The process of making takes about 100,000 years






DISTILLATION OF MINERAL OIL

- Heated petroleum oil is pumped into the fractionation column
- Lighter fractions condense at higher levels
- The distillation process can be done in several stages to produce other products

WHY IS MINERAL OIL USED IN SKINCARE?

- To use vegetable oil instead of mineral oil, is about 10 times the price.
- Olive oil is part of the life cycle and becomes more expensive to produce.





PRESERVATIVES



- Parabens
- Methylchloroisothiazolinone (Methyl chloro iso thia zolinone) and

Methylisothiazolinone (Methyl iso thia zolinone), commonly known as Kathon CG.

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CHEMICAL SUN PROTECTION

- Ethylhexyl methoxycinnamate, octyl methoxycinnamate
- Absorbed by the body/cells
- Stored in the body and degrades the liver
- Takes 20 minutes to protect from the sun
- Absorbs sun rays into the skin
- The product has a smooth feel that easily penetrates the skin
- Damages your skin and the environment
